### Prospective Athlete and Open Tryout Information

This is a competitive collegiate sports program. We are looking for fully committed and experienced baseball players who want to be good, loyal teammates with the opportunity to take home the NCBA Division II World Series Title in 2012. We are not looking for players who want to screw around and show up when you feel like it. This program is NOT for everyone so be sure you really want to be a part of something this intense.

#### Tryout Notes:

- Tryouts are MANDATORY. Except for EXTREME CIRCUMSTANCES, we will not allow a separate tryout. Remember, you're playing time is based off of dedication more than anything else and this should be the first thing you want to display to your coach.
- There are NO SPRING TRYOUTS - you must attend tryouts in the fall and all fall practices/games to be eligible for the conference roster in the spring.
  - Only exceptions are players who were not attending the university in the fall (transfer, etc.) or had a prior ATHLETIC obligation (other varsity sport) which restricted them from attending tryouts and playing in the fall. These separate tryouts are by coach's discretion and are not guaranteed.
- Please arrive minimum 15 minutes prior to start time.
- Please dress in appropriate baseball attire (baseball pants, cleats, etc.)
- Bring catchers gear if you are trying out as a catcher.
- Bring all baseball equipment as this will not be provided for you.
- If you are a pitcher, please indicate this on our prospective athlete tryout form.
- You must be a full time student at Hofstra University (12.0 credit hours) and if not a Freshman, a 2.0 GPA and not on academic probation
  - Grad students - you must also be considered a full time student (9.0 credit hours). Same academic standing applies
- It is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED that you have previous experience at the High School Varsity level, College level, or Legion.
- You must meet the moral standards/ethics of the program
- You must follow all team rules and policies at all times
- Finally, you must have respect for the game and play it the right way at all times.
